HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

If Presenter is providing lodging, Presenter will make reservations at a high-quality hotel equivalent to or better than Holiday Inn or Best Western. Artists require 6 (six) single-occupancy and 2 (two) double bed non-smoking rooms. Accommodations must have private bathroom facilities, free high speed internet access. Rooms need to have air conditioning.

TRANSPORTATION

If arriving by air, Hot 8 Brass Band will require transportation from the airport to the hotel and from hotel to venue for all performances, rehearsals, residency activities, load-in, etc:

- Vehicles to accommodate a group of ten (10) people plus their luggage, such as 15-passenger van and 1 mini-van with drivers.

*All arrangements must be finalized no later than **one (1) week** from artists' arrival date.*

HOSPITALITY

The following hospitality is for Hot 8 Brass Band musicians and personnel only.

Available at load-in:

- Two Dozen (24) bottles of water
- Assorted Fruit Juice (orange, cranberry, etc)
- Assorted Soft drinks (Coke and Sprite)
- veggie tray, fruit tray, chips, cookies

*Please make snack trays and beverages available to Hot 8 Brass Band until load out is complete.

HOT MEAL DINNER / CASH BUYOUT

Presenter needs to provide a cash buy-out of \$23 per person, payable to the group upon their arrival. All menus should be given to the group at this time along with the cash in order for the members to order in time to accommodate their meal schedule above.

DRESSING ROOMS

At least three (3) dressing rooms equipped with one (1) full length mirror, running water, dry towels, tables and chairs and a bathroom, available at load-in. Dressing rooms shall be secured during Hot 8 Brass Band's sound check and performance. *NOTE: Backstage access is limited to Hot 8 Brass Band musicians, personnel and venue staff only. All other individuals must get permission by company manager.*

CONCESSIONS

Hot 8 Brass Band sells CD's and other merch before the performance, during intermission, and after the performance. Presenter will provide a merch table and appropriate lighting.

PUBLICITY

BILLING: Hot 8 Brass Band

In all headline situations, Hot 8 Brass Band shall receive 100% billing in all advertising, promotions and publicity.

TECHNICAL RIDER HOT 8 BRASS BAND

PRODUCTION & STAGE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum stage requirement 8' x 6'
- Four (4) fans, 2 on each side of the stage
- 8 stage towels

SOUND SYSTEM

Hot 8 Brass Band will need the presenting organization to provide the following:

- Please refer to our Stage Plot document. If you are not able to provide an exact set-up as indicated on our stage plot please contact band's management
- A qualified sound engineer (s) with minimum of 3 years of experience to be present from sound check through to the end of the performance

Tuba's (Sousaphone) microphone is dropped inside of the instrument. No mic stand needed. Tuba player would like the use of the house bass amp if there is one.

CALL TIMES / SOUND CHECK ARRIVAL

Venue's stage to be set up as per "Stage plot document" when Hot 8 Brass band arrives for agreed sound check time. We ask the presenting organization to make sure that audio cables, monitor mixes and all microphones are set up PRIOR to band's arrival.

Sound engineer to perform LINE CHECK prior to band's start of the sound check. If presenting organization is unable to meet the specific time we ask that the venue / promoter contacts band's management minimum of 4 hours prior to agreed sound check times.

LIGHTS

48 dimmers @ 2.4kw with 48 channels of control
20 submasters
White cyclorama

If additional electrics are available, please duplicate the 3rd electric

A lighting technician must be available from load in through to end of performance. If these requirements cannot be met, please provide:

- Full front state illumination providing a warm wash
- Overhead stage wash (eg. Strip lights) with at least three (3) colours (red/blue/amber)
